How it works

Your call will be taken by a doctor or a receptionist, some basic information will be taken. If a home visit is appropriate, it will be arranged accordingly. Appointments can also be requested via email.

You will be visited by a family doctor who will carry out a thorough examination.

Investigative tests and assessments may be administered on site or arranged otherwise.

You will be contacted with these results by phone, email or in writing.

Our practitioners are equipped with most medications which can be dispensed to you on site if needed.

If you are required to be admitted to hospital, the doctor will liaise with the appropriate specialty to arrange a prompt admission and transfer.

DoctorsDirect is a completely mobile medical practice. Our aim is to provide a high standard of personalized medical care by experienced family doctors. Our doctors come to you to provide emergency or routine medical care in the comfort of your own home, office or hotel. It is a service designed for both convenience and necessity.

This service is pioneered by a British family doctor, who first qualified as a pharmacist in the UK before becoming a medical doctor. For many years she has worked as a General Practitioner in the UK, where house calls remain part of a GP's daily routine to this day.



We provide most services normally available in a medical centre.

Emergencies - chest infections, abdominal pain, etc.

Routine medical care - eg. Diabetes review, blood pressure monitoring, etc.

Preventative medicine - Blood testing such as: blood profiles, cholesterol checks. Annual physical check-ups, travel and childhood vaccinations, influenza vaccination, confidential sexually transmitted disease testing, postnatal care, verruca removals, etc.

Wound management - Wound dressing, post operative care, suturing simple wounds, removal of sutures, etc.

The main advantage is that there is no need to wait in a doctor's office. We come to you.

- 1 - Avoid the need to take time off work or school.
- 2 - If too unwell to visit a doctor's office.
- 3 - Avoid exposure to other sick people in waiting rooms.
- 4 - More than one patient can be seen on one visit.
